### 1. Villa Rosa Sauvignon Blanc, Curico, Chile

Lightly floral with a bright line running through it to give it a refreshing clean zippy wine. (1)

### 2. Chardonnay 2010/11, Urmeneta, Central Valley, Chile

This intense Chardonnay shows aromas of peach and pineapple, plus a hint of banana that all blend perfectly with sweet notes of vanilla (2)

### 3. Laroma Pinot Grigio, Araldica, IGT delle Venezie, Italy

### 4. Avanti Shiraz-Melbec, Bodegas Borbore, San Juan, Argentina

Richly coloured and scented it is an easy-drinking blend. With Shiraz taking centre stage to give a smoky, spicy palate supported by a firm malbec grip. (b)

### 6. Rioja Don Placero, Rioja, Spain

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## *White wines by the bottle*

### *15. Chardonnay-Viognier, Laurent Miquel, Pays d'Oc, France*

Melons and peaches are suggested in this soft southern wine, its lifted bouquet and supple flavour are quietly sensual. (2)

### *16. Chenin Blanc 2011/12, Brown Brothers, Victoria, Australia*

Intense citrus aromas lead into a palate of fine detailed flavours, richness, viscosity and pace. Here is Chenin Blanc as it should be, but rarely is, from the New World (3)

### *17. Chateau L'Oiseliniere de la Ramee, Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sur Lie, Chereau Carre, France*

Just what a good young Muscadet is all about. A suggestion of sea breeze over new-mown hay, some mineral cool, finished with calm length. (1)

### *18. Mount Riley Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand*

Outstanding in its class, it has all the hallmarks of a proper, classic kiwi Sauvignon - grassy and netty with lean racing purity. Thoroughly bracing, it has intense citrus and gooseberry flavours that vie for attention. (1)

### *19. Chablis, Le Manoir, France*

Attractive young Chablis with its cool signature style of wet pebbles. (2)

### *20. Sancerre, Domaine Neveu, France*

A classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness. (1)

### *21. Prosecco Extra Dry NV, Ponte*

Clean, dry and crisp, with a creamy finish (1)

### *22. Mirabello Pinot Grigio Spumante, Italy*

Vibrant and sparkly with floral, sherbet and pear aromas. An attractive wine that is crisp and refreshing with plenty of citrus and flower pinot grigio flavours. Bright and easy and very moreish. (2)

### *23. Ponsard Brut NV, Champagne, France*

Champagne Ponsard is a sous-label from the renowned 'de Castellaine' in Epernay, which is owned by the Laurent-Perrier Group. It has a delicious full yeasty aroma from the Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes. (1)

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## *Red wines by the bottle*

### *8. Nuviana Tempranillo-Cabernet, Valle del Cinca, Spain*

A wine which is single-handedly shining a light on its quiet corner of Aragon. It has an "ooh" factor of soft ripe fruit at the very first sniff and holds a fresh lean long line of flavour perfectly. (c)

### *9. Tanguero Malbec, Finca Flichman, Mendoza, Argentina*

An expressive young wine packed with red fruits and aromatic floral notes. A bright mouthful of generous character. (c)

### *10. Merlot 2009/10, Laroche, Languedoc, France*

Real purple. Rich Merlot smell. Velvet-textured fruit flavours and a splash of oak to firm the taste and shape the finish. (c)

### *11. Mazuelo Rioja Crianza, Azabache, Spain*

Instantly attractive combination of vital strawberry fruit and soft oak flavours that is the hallmark of Rioja - and its universal appeal.

Very satisfying. (c)

### *12. Rolling Shiraz, Orange, Australia*

A wine of fine cool elegance drawn from it's high altitude vineyards and the famed skills of the cumulus winemaking team. Pured peppered black fruit is supported by fine velvet tannins. (d)

### *13. Devil's Corner Pinot Noir, Tamar Ridge, Tasmania*

This is no shrinking violet Pinot Noir. It is full of cinnamon spice and cherry fruit with attractive burnt-toffee notes. It is silky smooth with elegant fine tannins to bring out the berry fruits. One of the neatest and most elegant Pinots we have found Down Under for years. (b)

### *14. Cotes du Rhone Nature, Domaine Perrin, France*

Made in supple spicy Syrah style. This juicy and effortlessly-delicious wine has then Perrin family fingerprints all over it. The grapes have been grown organically. (c)
